Organization of the Greek Group – Co-Founder / Deputy Director of Cochrane Greece

Deputy Director, Cochrane Greece, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH), since 11 March 2021. Member of the **Cochrane Collaboration since 2006**, initially within the *Menstrual Disorders and Subfertility Group* and currently within the *Cochrane Gynecology and Fertility Group*. Progression through multiple levels of the Collaboration and serve as an **official Cochrane Editor since 2012**, as well as **Associate Editor for Cochrane Clinical Answers**.

Principal initiator and founding contributor to the establishment of the Cochrane Collaboration in Greece, organizing the initial strategic meetings, **nine national workshops** (2012, 2013, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021-23), and the **Cochrane Mid-Year Meeting** accompanied by **five parallel workshops** (2015).

The Greek Cochrane group is currently expanding, with a **core membership of more than 20 researchers / authors**, predominantly affiliated with the **National and Kapodistrian University of Athens**. Dedicated office space and administrative support have been formally provided by the **Medical School of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens** (AKISA Building), following approval by the General Assembly of the Medical School (13 December 2017).

In collaboration with the **Aristotle University of Thessaloniki**, we successfully achieved the **official establishment of Cochrane Greece** (18 June 2020), confirmed by formal correspondence from **Mark Wilson, Executive Officer, Cochrane Central Executive**. The **official launch event** was held on 22 July 2020, with the participation of senior representatives of the academic and governmental leadership. Formal appointment as **Deputy Director of Cochrane Greece** was ratified by the General Assemblies of both **AUTH** (Decision No. 25/27-04-2021) and **NKUA** (Decision 06-05-2021).
